BY-LAW 2018-42

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2012-26, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE
FOR THE PREVENTION AND SPREADING OF FIRES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY**

WHEREAS Section 7.1(1) of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O. 1997, c. 4 provides that a council of a municipality may pass by-laws:

- a) Regulating fire prevention, including the prevention of the spreading of fires;
- b) Regulating the setting of open air fires, including establishing the times during which open air fires may be set;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of St.-Charles enacted By-law 2012-26, being a by-law to provide for the prevention and spreading of fires within the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of St.-Charles deems it advisable to amend By-law 2012-26;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF ST.-CHARLES HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Deleting Section 12 of By-law 2012-26 in its entirety and substituting the following:
 12. THAT the cost for extinguishing shall be Four Hundred Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars per firefighting unit for the first hour or part thereof, and Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars per additional half (1/2) hour or part thereof. Each additional firefighting unit needed will be at a cost of Four Hundred Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars per hour or part thereof.
2. Deleting Section 14 of By-law 2012-26 in its entirety and substituting the following:
 14. THAT the cost per hour for responses to Ontario Ministry of Transportation incidents shall be the current Ontario Ministry of Transportation response rates and shall apply for non-residents of the Municipality of St.-Charles.
3. Adding the following paragraph as Section 15 of By-law 2012-26:
 15. THAT the schedule of fees for fire permits and inspections is

attached as Schedule "A" and forms part of this by-law.

4. Deleting Appendix "A" to By-law 2012-26 in its entirety and substituting the Schedule "A" as attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
5. THAT all other provisions of By-law 2012-26, as amended, remain in full force and effect.
6. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day it is passed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15TH DAY OF AUGUST 2018.

SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR FIRE PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS

Type of Permit	Duration	Cost of Permit
1. Yearly Pass*	One (1) year	\$50.00 (HST included)
2. Daily Pass*	Five (5) days maximum	\$5.00 per day (HST included)

Cost of Inspection

1. Per each inspection \$115.00 (HST included)
